- ★ **Gender:** At the Senior Leadership level of the *United States Agency for International Development*, female representation is at **91%**, greatly exceeding parity.
- ★ **Race/Ethnicity:** White Americans occupy the majority of these positions, with People of Color (POC) representation only at 36%.
- ★ **Call to Action:** USAID must continue to be mindful in hiring people from historically excluded communities, especially Native Americans and People with Disabilities.

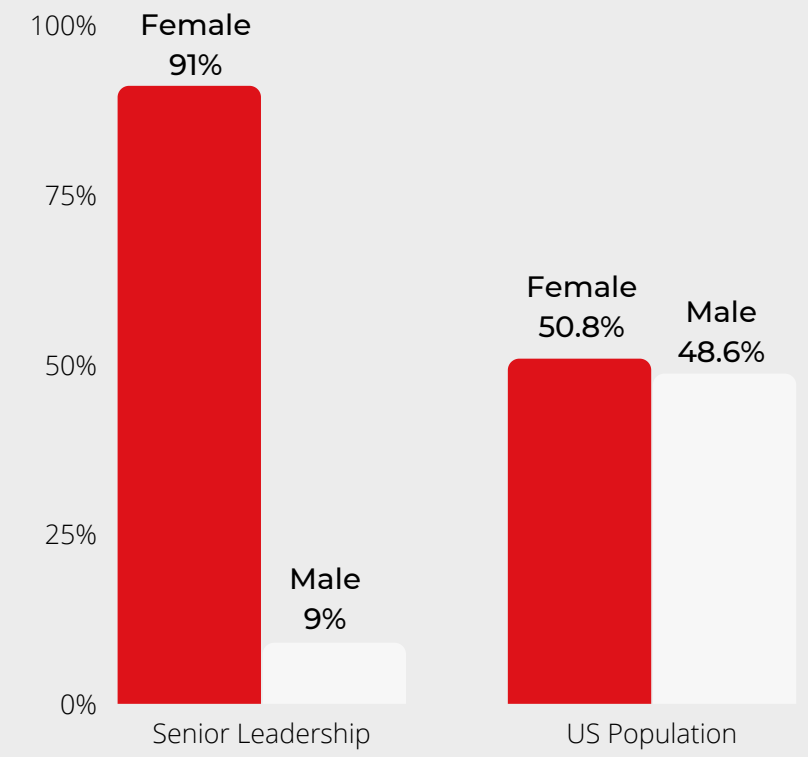

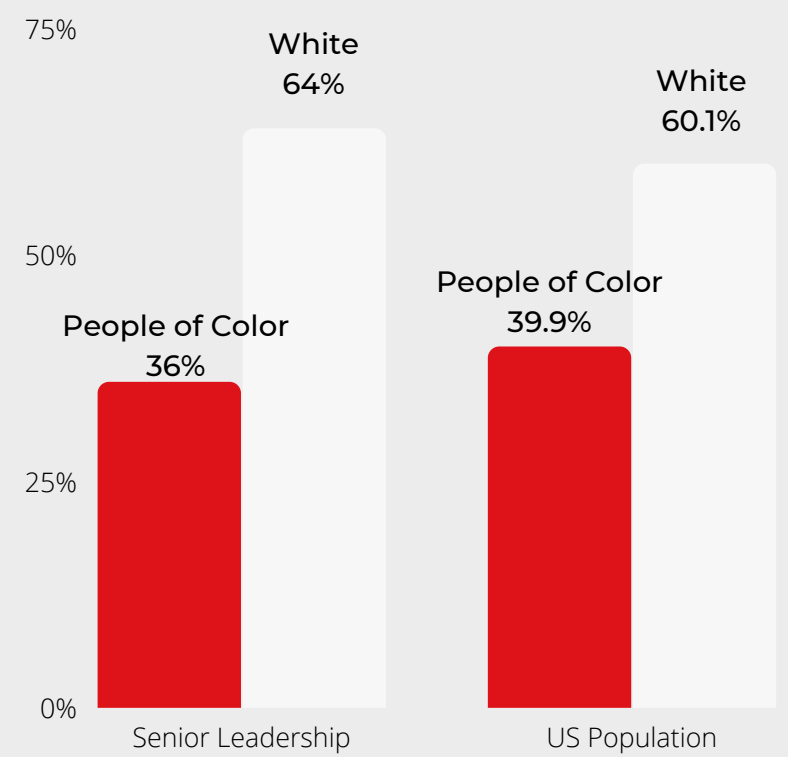
